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Rationale

India's textiles sector is one of the oldest industries in Indian economy and contributes around 14 per cent to industrial production and 4 per cent to GDP. It is one of the largest contributors to India's exports with approximately 13 per cent of total exports. The textile industry is also labor intensive and employs about 105 million people directly and indirectly. Textile industry has two broad segments: Unorganised sector (handloom, handicrafts and sericulture) and Organised sector (spinning, apparel and garments segment which apply modern machinery and techniques). Textile industry is paving the way for new opportunities. Recently the textile entrepreneurs are focusing on the aspects i.e light weight, eco-friendly, providing better and comfort properties, reuse of dyes/chemicals and value added products from textile wastes resulting in many innovations with variety of textile product end uses: apparel, home textiles, transportation, industrial, geotextiles, Protective Textiles, Sport textiles and medical textiles.

The present workshop provides a platform to all the stakeholders to discuss various innovations taking place in textile sector around the globe from fibre to finished goods stage. It also highlights the role of patents in promotion of new technologies in India and global with relevant case studies.
