PARTICULARS OF ANY ARRANGEMENT THAT EXISTS FOR CONSULTATION WITH OR REPRESENTATION BY THE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC IN RELATION TO THE FORMULATION OF ITS POLICY OR IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF

- I. As has been envisaged in the Memorandum of Association, the governance of the Institute is in the hands of the Governing Council supported by Executive Committee. The AGM (Society) is the apex body. In all these high power committees, most of the members are senior officers from the Central Government and state governments.
- II. The implementation of the policy as laid down by EC/GC/Society are executed by the local chief of the Institute i.e Director General, who executes the policies duly supported by the officers as are existing with the approval of the Governing Council on the rolls of the Institute.
